

## Legend Acoustics launches Kama 6 & Joey 6

Multiple award-winning Australian loudspeaker manufacturer Legend Acoustics have just launched the series 6 versions of their popular floor-standing Kama & book-shelf Joey loudspeakers. Dr Rod Crawford of Legend Acoustics said the main change to both was a much improved silk-dome tweeter. “With a larger and improved magnet structure the tweeter is more efficient and has higher power handling capabilities with a frequency response that extends to above 30 kHz” he claimed. “Also a much larger back-cavity enables the tweeter to be crossed-over to the mid-bass units at a lower frequency, improving the dispersion and lowering distortion in the lower treble/upper midrange”. The Kama 6 and Joey 6, which are both designed and built in Australia unlike many of their competitors, retain their doped-paper cone bass/midrange units. These, along with the complex cabinets which reduce resonances and diffraction effects, help give the speakers their famous ‘fast open natural sound’ Dr Crawford said. However, the Kama 6 is now a true 2.5 way loudspeaker with the lower mid-bass unit rolling off above 800Hz which, combined with its new dual-port bass system, give it a ‘bigger’ sound. Suggested retail prices are \$990 for the Joey 6 and \$1990 for the Kama 6.
