

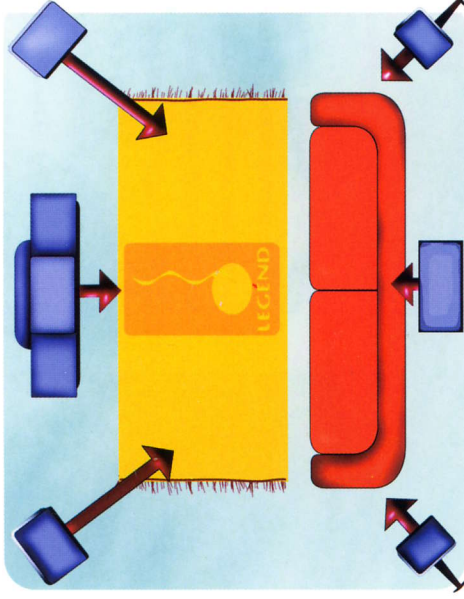
## Design

Kama, Kantu, Kurka, Kurlo, Kurre etc are all Australian indigenous language names for kangaroos, chosen to reflect the Australian origin of these speakers and their characteristic "fast open" sound. Kangaroos are fast agile animals that inhabit the flat open Australian landscape; Legend speakers are fast and agile with very flat response to create a breath-takingly open sound.

Our cabinets are innovatively built in Australia, our drivers are sourced from leading manufacturers and our crossovers employ the finest electronic components from around the world. But "world-class" means designing a whole that is more than the sum of the parts - requiring a love of music and a deep understanding of the physics and technology involved in speaker design.

## Kantu

## Kama

The Kamas share many of the design features of the Kantus but at a lower price. ## Kurlo

With a sealed cabinet and 350W peak from its built-in amplifier, Legend's Kurlo 3 subwoofer will add powerful, deep (flat to 20Hz) yet fast tightly controlled bass to any home theatre system producing extra excitement and drama for the enjoyment of your movies. Awarding it Subwoofer of the Year for 2004 AVL magazine said "This is one of the cleanest, tightest and most musical subs I have heard."



## Kurre

The SMH Guide May 2005 said the Kurre 4s "combine professional studio monitor accuracy with unusually high level of clarity without losing the elusive warmth that is essential if a speaker is to sound truly musical." They were judged "Highly Recommended Audiophile Speakers" in the 2005 Sound & Image awards.



## Kanga

The Kangas are designed as centre speakers for home theatre surround sound systems containing the Kamas and Joeys to give identical sound character to them. In addition, when turned on their sides as mini-towers, the Kangas make superb main L&R speakers for stereo or home-theatre systems.



## Joey

Joey is the baby of Legend's 'Kangaroo' range with the same fast, open Australian sound. They are superb as rear speakers in a home theatre system with their bigger siblings - or as excellent front speakers in their own right. The SMH Guide said "The sound was fabulous, particularly across the mid-range, where it was precise and unfailingly accurate... Bass response was exceptional. The Joeys are a real giant killer...Magic!"



## Kurka

The Kurka is a dedicated centre speaker for a top-of-the range home-theatre system, using the same components as the Kantus and Kurras. The system won the Sound & Image Home Theatre Best Award. "Front sound precision was excellent, with lateral sound panning completely smooth".



## Kurlette

The smaller Kurlette is based on the legendary Kurlo 3 subwoofer. Like its bigger brother, the Kurlette uses a sealed cabinet for best speed and transient response. It is flat to below 30 Hz.



## Roo

The Roos are dedicated rear channel speakers that are semi-bipoles. A single bass-mid unit is omnidirectional in its frequency range while a pair of tweeters on the 45 degree faces provide better dispersion of the treble. They are entirely covered in stretchable Lycra fabric which can be changed for different decor needs.
